THE KING IS CALLING THOSE...

1. WHO HAVE _____

Blessed are the merciful...

James 2:13 (NIRV) Those who have not shown mercy will not receive mercy when they are judged. To show mercy is better than to judge.

Matthew 18:35 (ESV) So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart.

Luke 6:36 (NIRV) So have mercy, just as your Father has mercy.

Micah 6:8 (NLT) No, O people, the LORD has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.

2. WHO ARE _____

Blessed are the pure in heart...

Proverbs 22:11 (ESV) He who loves purity of heart, and whose speech is gracious, will have the king as his friend.

Psalms 24:3-4 (ESV) Who shall ascend the hill of the LORD? And who shall stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully.

Proverbs 20:9 (NIRV) No one can say, I have kept my heart pure. I'm clean. I haven't sinned.

Jeremiah 17:9-10 (NLT) The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is? But I, the LORD, search all hearts and examine secret motives.

3. WHO PUT AN _____

Blessed are the peacemakers...

Isaiah 26:3 (NLT) You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

Isaiah 52:7 (NIRV) What a beautiful sight it is to see messengers coming with good news! How beautiful to see them coming down from the mountains with a message about peace!

Isaiah 9:6 (NIRV) A child will be born to us. A son will be given to us. He will rule over us. And he will be called Wonderful Adviser and Mighty God. He will also be called Father Who Lives Forever and Prince Who Brings Peace.

4. WHO WILL _____

Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness sake...

Luke 6:22 (NIRV) Blessed are you when people hate you, when they have nothing to do with you and say bad things about you, and when they treat your name as something evil. They do all this because you are followers of the Son of Man.

1 Peter 4:14 (NIRV) Suppose people make fun of you because you believe in Christ. Then you are blessed, because God's Spirit rests on you. He is the Spirit of glory.

Matthew 5:13-16 (ESV) You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.
