Matthew 28:19-20 (ESV) Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, **baptizing them** in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **teaching them** to observe all that I have commanded you.

Matthew 16:24 (NIV) Then Jesus said to his disciples, whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.

Mark 8:34 (TNIV) Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.

Luke 14:27 (ESV) Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple.

John 12:26 (NLT) Anyone who wants to be my disciple must follow me, because my servants must be where I am. And the Father will honor anyone who serves me.

Proverbs 11:30 (CEV) Live right, and you will eat from the life-giving tree. And if you act wisely, others will follow.

1. I MUST _____

Mark 12:30-31 (ESV) And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these.

Proverbs 3:3 (ESV) Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart.

2. I MUST _____

Proverbs 3:5-7 (HCSV) Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; think about Him in all your ways, and He will guide you on the right paths.

Proverbs 2:1-9 (NCV) My child, listen to what I say and remember what I command you. Listen carefully to wisdom; set your mind on understanding. ... Then you will understand what is honest and fair and what is the good and right thing to do.

Proverbs 12:15 (NLT) Fools think their own way is right, but the wise listen to others.

3. I MUST _____

Proverbs 10:9 (ESV) Whoever walks in **integrity** walks securely, but he who makes his ways crooked will be found out.

Proverbs 11:24-25 (NET) One person is generous and yet grows more wealthy, but another withholds more than he should and comes to poverty. A generous person will be enriched, and the one who provides water for others will himself be satisfied.

Proverbs 21:21 (TNK) He who strives to do good and kind deeds Attains life, success, and honor.

Proverbs 11:30 (CEV) Live right, and you will eat from the life-giving tree. And if you act wisely, others will follow.
