Deuteronomy 6:16(ESV) You shall not put the Lord your God to the test, as you tested him at Massah.

TWO WAYS GOD TESTS US

THE ISSUE IS SUBMISSION TO AUTHORITY

1. WITH CONSCIENTIOUS

Deuteronomy 6:17 (ESV) You shall diligently keep the commandments of the Lord your God, and his testimonies and his statutes, which he has commanded you.

Psalm 78:6-8 (NLT) so the next generation might know them—even the children not yet born—and they in turn will teach their own children. So each generation should set its hope anew on God, not forgetting his glorious miracles and obeying his commands. Then they will not be like their ancestors—stubborn, rebellious, and unfaithful, refusing to give their hearts to God.

2. WITH LIVING Deuteronomy 6:18a (ESV) And you shall do what is right and good in the sight of the Lord
3. WITH IN GOD'S GOODNESS Deuteronomy 6:18b that it may go well with you and that you may go in and take possession of the good land that the Lord swore to give to your fathers Mark 4:38 (ESV) But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion.
