

**DEUTERONOMY 2008-2009**

**Part 45 – TEN MORE COMMANDMENTS - Deut 24:1-22**

- 1. PROTECT THE \_\_\_\_\_**  
**Vs 1-7 (ESV)** When a man takes a wife and marries her, if then she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some indecency in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce and puts it in her hand and sends her out of his house, and she departs out of his house, and if she goes and becomes another man's wife, and the latter man hates her and writes her a certificate of divorce (See overhead)
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_ THE NATIONAL UNIT**  
**Vs 5** When a man is newly married, he shall not go out with the army or be liable for any other public duty. He shall be free at home one year to be happy with his wife whom he has taken.
- 3. PREVENT \_\_\_\_\_ KIDNAPPING**  
**Vs 6** No one shall take a mill or an upper millstone in pledge, for that would be taking a life in pledge.
- 4. PREVENT ALL \_\_\_\_\_**  
**Vs 7** If a man is found stealing one of his brothers of the people of Israel, and if he treats him as a slave or sells him, then that thief shall die. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.
- 5. TRUST GOD WITH \_\_\_\_\_**  
**Vs 8-9** Take care, in a case of leprous disease, to be very careful to do according to all that the Levitical priests shall direct you. As I commanded them, so you shall be careful to do. Remember what the Lord your God did to Miriam on the way as you came out of Egypt.

- 6. MERCY EQUALS \_\_\_\_\_**  
**Vs 10-13** When you make your neighbor a loan of any sort, you shall not go into his house to collect his pledge. You shall stand outside, and the man to whom you make the loan shall bring the pledge out to you. And if he is a poor man, you shall not sleep in his pledge. You shall restore to him the pledge as the sun sets, that he may sleep in his cloak and bless you. And it shall be righteousness for you before the Lord your God.
- 7. OPPRESSION OF POOR = \_\_\_\_\_**  
**Vs 14-15** You shall not oppress a hired servant who is poor and needy, whether he is one of your brothers or one of the sojourners who are in your land within your towns. You shall give him his wages on the same day, before the sun sets (for he is poor and counts on it), lest he cry against you to the Lord, and you be guilty of sin.
- 8. \_\_\_\_\_ IS GOD'S ONLY**  
**Vs 16** Fathers shall not be put to death because of their children, nor shall children be put to death because of their fathers. Each one shall be put to death for his own sin.
- 9. DON'T \_\_\_\_\_ THE POOR**  
**Vs 17** You shall not pervert the justice due to the sojourner or to the fatherless, or take a widow's garment in pledge, but you shall remember that you were a slave in Egypt and the Lord your God redeemed you from there; therefore I command you to do this.
- 10 BE \_\_\_\_\_ WITH LESS FORTUNATE**  
**Vs 19-22** When you reap your harvest in your field and forget a sheaf in the field, you shall not go back to get it. (See overhead)
