Matthew 16:28 (ESV) Truly, I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.

THE TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS

THE PLACE: A _____
Matthew 17:1 (ESV) And after six days Jesus took with him Peter and James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves.

THE PICTURE: A _____ OF JESUS
Matthew 17:2 (ESV) And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light.
2 Peter 1:16 (ESV) For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.
John 1:14 (ESV) And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Matthew 17:3 (ESV) And behold, there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with him.

THE PROPOSAL: PETER'S _____
Matthew 17:4 (ESV) And Peter said to Jesus, Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah.

THE PRONOUNCEMENT: A WORD FROM _____
Matthew 17:5 (ESV) He was still speaking when, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.
Deuteronomy 18:15 (ESV) The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers—it is to him you shall listen...

THE PROMISE: THE _____
Matthew 17:6-9 (ESV) When the disciples heard this, they fell on their faces and were terrified. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, Rise, and have no fear. And when they lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only. And as they were coming down the mountain, Jesus commanded them, Tell no one the vision, until the Son of Man is raised from the dead.
Revelation 21:3-4 (ESV) And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.
