Psalm 122:1 (ESV) I was glad when they said to me, Let us go to the house of the Lord!

1. GOD'S ORIGINAL _____

Vs 1-2 (ESV) It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to your name, O Most High; to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night...

Genesis 1:31 (ESV) And God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

2. GOD'S ETERNAL _____

Vs 3-5 ...to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre. For you, O Lord, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy. How great are your works, O Lord! Your thoughts are very deep!

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) I know the plans (thoughts) I have for you, declares the Lord; plans to prosper you, not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Revelation 22:14-15 (ESV) Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates. Outside are the dogs and sorcerers and the sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.

3. GOD'S _____

Vs 6-9 (ESV) The stupid man cannot know; the fool cannot understand this: that though the wicked sprout like grass and all evildoers flourish, they are doomed to destruction forever; but you, O Lord, are on high forever. For behold, your enemies, O Lord, for behold, your enemies shall perish; all evildoers shall be scattered.

Genesis 2:18 (ESV) Then the Lord God said, It is not good that the man should be alone...

4. GOD'S ULTIMATE PERSONAL _____

Vs 10 (ESV) But you have exalted my horn like that of the wild ox; you have poured over me fresh oil.

5. GOD'S ULTIMATE _____

Vs 11 (ESV) My eyes have seen the downfall of my enemies; my ears have heard the doom of my evil assailants.

6. GOD'S ULTIMATE _____

Vs 12-15 (ESV) The righteous flourish like the palm tree and grow like a cedar in Lebanon. They are planted in the house of the Lord; they flourish in the courts of our God. They still bear fruit in old age; they are ever full of sap and green, to declare that the Lord is upright; he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.
